


Rules of the Games - Major Wording Modifications

(words in bold are the update to the existing Rules)

VOLLEYBALL

Existing Text	Proposed New Text
<p>Rule 4 Teams</p> <p>4.1 TEAM COMPOSITION</p> <p>4.1.1 A team may consist of up to 14 players (a maximum of 12 regular players), one coach, one assistant coach, one trainer and one medical doctor.</p> <p>For FIVB World and Official Competitions, the medical doctor must be accredited beforehand by the FIVB.</p> <p>New </p> <p>Rule 12 Service</p> <p>12.5 SCREENING</p> <p>12.5.1 The players of the serving team must not prevent their opponent, through individual or collective screening, from seeing the server or the flight path of the ball.</p> <p>12.5.2 A player, or group of players, of the serving team makes a screen by waving arms, jumping or moving sideways, during the execution of the service, or by standing grouped to hide the flight path of the ball.</p> <p>Rule 19 The Libero Player</p> <p>The consequences of an illegal Libero replacement are the same as those for a rotational fault.</p> <p>19.3.2.2 The Acting Libero can only be replaced by the regular replacement player for that position, or by the second Libero.</p>	<p>Rule 4 Teams</p> <p>4.1 TEAM COMPOSITION</p> <p>4.1.1 For the match, a team may consist of up to 12 players, plus</p> <p>* Coaching Staff: one coach, a maximum of two assistant coaches,</p> <p>* Medical Staff: one team therapist and one medical doctor.</p> <p>Only those listed on the score sheet may normally enter the Competition/ Control Area and take part in the official warm up and in the match.</p> <p>For FIVB, World and Official Competitions the medical doctor and physiotherapist must be accredited beforehand by the FIVB.</p> <p>Rule 9</p> <p>9.2.4 It is a fault, during the reception of service, to make a double contact or catch using an overhand finger action.</p> <p>Rule 12 Service</p> <p>12.5 SCREENING</p> <p>12.5.1 The players of the serving team must not prevent their opponent, through individual or collective screening, from seeing the server or AND the flight path of the ball.</p> <p>12.5.2 A player or a group of players of the serving team make(s) a screen by waving arms, jumping or moving sideways during the execution of the service, or by standing grouped to hide the server AND the flight path of the ball.</p> <p>Rule 19 The Libero Player</p> <p>19.3.2 REPLACEMENTS OF PLAYERS</p> <p>19.3.2.9 An illegal Libero replacement can involve (amongst others)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No completed rally between Libero replacements - The Libero being replaced by a player other than the regular replacement player or the second Libero <p>An illegal Libero replacement should be considered in the same way as an illegal substitution:</p>
